## Art, Design Technology and Science

This half term we will be linking our art and DT to our topics. In DT we will be using equipment to make our own mechanical systems. This will involve measuring, sawing and creating their own structures.

In Science we are continuing with our topic 'Light' where we will be exploring how we see, the relationship between light, objects and shadows, the colour of light and how lighthouses work.

## Computing

Your child will have focussed Computing lessons each term. This half term's focus will be on 'Programming – Sensing'. This topic allows the children to understand mini – computers (microbits). They will be using the microbits to create a device that uses inputs and outputs to create data.

Across all areas of the curriculum, we will be using the internet for research in order to develop digital literacy skills.

### Homework

Spelling tests will take place on Thursday mornings and spellings will be handed out on the Thursday for the following week. The lists can be found in reading diaries. The spellings for the whole of Spring one are available on our class page on the website.

## <u>Reading</u>

Please hear your child read and record this in your child's diary. This can be a school reading book, an online reading book or a reading material of your choice at home. We encourage the idea of reading for pleasure and the children reading what they enjoy. Reading homework could even be heading to the local library every few weeks.




## Geography:

Our lessons this half term will be focusing on world maps, time zones and language linked to the mapping of Earth:

- Mapping the World
- Longitude and Latitude
- Understanding Time Zones
- Exploring Different Maps

As part of this we will be using the text 'The Picture Atlas an Incredible Journey' by Simon Holland and 'The Maps Book' by Lonely Planet.





## **English**

In this term's English lessons, we will be focussing on the story of the Flannan Island Mystery which looks at the sudden disappearance of three lighthouse keepers:

From this clip we will be writing diary entries and writing an explanation on how lighthouses work.

### Maths

## Spring 1:

A huge focus on fractions including:

Developing our understanding of what fractions are.

Equivalent fractions

Improper fractions to mixed numbers.

Mixed numbers to improper fractions.

Fractions on number lines.

Ordering and comparing fractions, including addition and subtraction.

Addition for mixed numbers.

Multiplication and division with fractions.

### Music

In music the children will be exploring the different instruments we have in school and the drawing of notes. Music will be taught by Mrs. Cooke.

## PE

PE will take place every Tuesday afternoon with Isaac. Children will need to arrive dressed in their PE kit for the day. This half term they will be recapping the fundamentals used to participate in most sports through Benchball.
